
ORDER

Whereas the association, Tuticorin Diocese Association, Bishop's House, Tuticorin, Tamil Nadu- 628001 is registered under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976.

Whereas the inspection of the account and records of the above said association undertaken from 10th to 13th January 2012 under provision of Section 20 and 23 of Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010 revealed that the association has violated the provisions of FC(R) Act, 2010.

And whereas the Central Government, having regard to the information and evidence in its possession, is satisfied that the acceptance of foreign contribution by the said association is likely to prejudicially affect public interest.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Section 9 & 10 of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010 and without prejudice to the other provision of the said Act, the Central Government hereby prohibits, in public interest, the association namely 'Tuticorin Diocese Association' to receive foreign contribution from the date of issue of this order.


