Hon'ble Court by its order dated 12. 11.2007. The Hon'ble Full Bench in para 11 and 12 observed as follows:

"Corporate Management is something that is recognized in the Act. Rule 15 of the Tamil Nadu Recognized Private Schools (Regulation) Rules, 1974, which deals with qualifications and conditions of service of teachers and other persons, provides that "In respect of corporate body running more than one school, the schools under that body shall be treated as one unit for the purpose of this rule." Therefore, the Management of several schools by one corporate body certainly

has statutory recognition.

"The Full Bench did not consider the facts and circumstances relating to the petitioner, which claims that it is a corporate body running several schools and also maintaining the single seniority list. The factual aspects of Malankara Syrian Catholic Arch Diocese alone has been dealt with by the Full Bench and a decision has been given thereon. The petitioner has produced certain documents to show that it stands at a different footing and dealing with the petitioner on the same basis as Malankara Syrian Catholic Arch Diocese, is an error apparent and the petitioner is entitled to have its request for sanction of salaries dealt with independently on the basis of the records produced. In these circumstances, the petitioner's grievance that its right has been jeopardized by linking its case with the case of another situation which stands on a different footing definitely merits acceptance."

In the operative portion of the order, the Hon'ble Full Bench held in para 13 as follows:

"The Full Bench decision need not be reviewed in its entirety since the Full Bench in answer to the question whether transfer is an incident of service had indeed observed that there may be facts and circumstances where transfer would be an incident of
