Superintendent, Rev. Fr. Dominic Arul Valan had other regular duties and also was not fully informed of this case or the case history, as soon as he assumed charges. The Educational Agency and all those who are involved are aware of this fact. That is why the management deputed Fr. M.G. Victor to do the same. There is no impersonation, fraud or mala-fide as alleged by the applicant. The Manager has got power and liberty, to depute Fr. M.G. Victor to discharge his duties, as Superintendent in respect of this particular case. As both the Writ Appeal and Review Petition before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras were filed by Fr. M.G. Victor, this 1<sup>st</sup> Appellant/Bishop as the Manager had asked him to continue to follow the case so that there are no lapses. Therefore, there is no mala-fide or mis-representation in this regard. For the purpose of continuity and to avoid lapses, the 1<sup>st</sup> Appellant, Manager/Bishop is entitled to get the assistance of anyone and authorize him as Superintendent of R.C. Schools. 4. It is humbly submitted that the allegation that Mr. Peterraj, the delinquent teacher, was forced by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Appellant/Petitioner to accept compulsory retirement is incorrect. Fr. M.G. Victor has no power or necessity to decide the punishment or to compel the
