


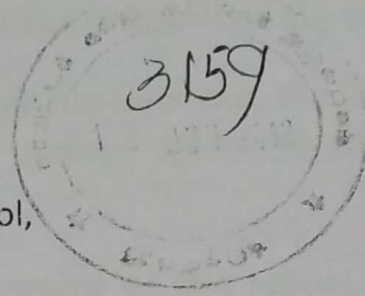

**Sub : St.Mary's Hss, Pothakalanvilai – Sanctioning of Salary for
the month of May-2013 - regarding.**

I have noted with regret that the salary for the month of May for our school is pending with your office.

I have received no communication from you with regard to this matter but understand that you have not signed the salary bill saying that one Mr.Peter Raj informed you by wire to stop payment for Mr.Jeyaseelan Antony Raj, our History P.G.Assistant citing high court verdict in his long pending case against R.C.Management, Thoothukudi Diocese.

I have no intention to go deep into the merit and demerit of this case but I am very much concerned the way salary is stopped for my school staff abruptly.

I would like to politely urge you to reconsider your decision of the extreme step of stoppage of salary in the larger interest of basic survival of government staff involved in this case who will be pushed to the extreme situation of mental distress and agony.

This case is pending before the honourable high court since 1998....

Since then this individual has been in the habit of flooding the DEO/ CEO offices with letters/telegrams to exert undue pressure on our school.

Though the verdict from high court bench has been out, the legal battle is still not over as we have filed a Review petition S.R.22190/2013 at the High court, Madurai.

As one holding the office of correspondent of this school, I can give you solemn assurance that my school is binding in any action taken in this regard in the event of your releasing this month's salary in toto may bring you disrepute or any departmental proceedings in course of time.

In the absence of Specific direction from the court to stop salary for a regular staff which is also not expressed in this verdict, abrupt stoppage merely because of an individual's telegram is undesirable which action will compel our school to go in appeal to the higher echelons/forums/court of law available with us.
